Requirements:

To be a student at Shumen University (undergraduate and graduate students).

English Language: Level B1

What do you get?

Erasmus grant: 79 euro per day (5 days physical mobility + up to 2 days for travel)

ECTS credits: 3

Learning outcomes:

By the end of the programme, participants will be able to:

- Increased level of knowledge and skills: Participants will gain an increased level of knowledge and skills regarding first aid provision. They will also get a deeper understanding of how to respond to emergency situations (natural disasters, medical emergencies, violence on campus, cases of drug or alcohol addiction, etc);
- Broadening the horizons and development of lasting professional relationships through access to a wide range of expertise and insights from specialists in different fields.
- Development of transversal skills such as communication skills, language skills, critical thinking, problem solving, and intercultural skills.
- Broadening the network of contacts: the workshops and group discussions will provide participants with networking opportunities and connections with relevant people.
